See at a glance the status of a case or statute.

-  A red flag warns that the case is no longer good law for at least one of the points it contains.
-  A yellow flag warns that the case has some negative history, but hasn’t been reversed.
-  A blue H indicates that the case has some history.
-  A green C indicates that the case or statute has citing references.
-  Quotes indicate the citing case directly quotes the cited case.

Depth of treatment stars tell you how much the citing case discusses the cited case.

-  EXAMINED – extended discussion of the cited case
-  DISCUSSED – substantial discussion of the cited case
-  CITED – some discussion of the cited case
-  MENTIONED – brief reference to the cited case
