UPGRADE TO MICROSOFT® SQL SERVER 2019 EXPRESS

Case Notebook suite was upgraded from Microsoft® SQL Server 2014 Service Pack 3 (SP3) Express to Microsoft® SQL Server 2019 Express, which is a more powerful, reliable, and modern SQL solution.

The following enhancements were made in Case Notebook Administration to support this upgrade:

- SQL Server 2019 is supported only on 64-bit platforms, therefore an easy-to-use repository migration tool is available for users with an existing 32-bit SQL Server repository instance.
- Case Notebook automatically detects if the users' current repository resides on a SQL Server instance that is outdated.
- Upon login to Case Notebook Administration, users that are running the application on an outdated SQL Server instance are prompted to upgrade their repository to the current version of SQL Server for improved security and performance. Users have the option to start the migration process immediately, or do it later at their convenience. If they choose to proceed, a step-by-step wizard guides them through the migration process. Once the repository migration is complete, they are presented with an option to perform case migration immediately or later. For users that choose to perform the repository migration at a later time, a new menu item, **Migrate Repository**, is available in the existing list of options under the **Repository** menu.
- Users have the ability to perform case migration from a new menu item, **Migrate**, which is available in the existing list of options under the **Case** menu.
- Users have the ability to export cases in their entirety from a new menu item, **Export**, which is available in the existing list of options under the **Case** menu.
- A new file type, Cabinet files (.cab), was added to the list of existing file types which can be imported from the **Case > Batch Import** menu item which gives users the ability to import cases in their entirety.

Note: Users have the option to install Microsoft® SQL Server 2019 Express with the Repository. If they choose not to install Microsoft® SQL Server 2019 Express, then they can install Case Notebook Administration (NoSQL), and attach Case Notebook Administration to an existing repository (in Case Notebook Administration, close any open repositories, select the 'Repository' menu and then select 'Install SQL Server Repository').

The following enhancements were made in Case Notebook to support this upgrade:

- Once the repository migration is complete, upon login to Case Notebook, users are presented with a 'Repository Update Check' dialog box to inform them that the repositories in their list may be out of date.
- Users can click 'Yes' to check for updated repositories immediately. If users click 'No,' the dialog box is presented again at the next login, unless the 'Don't show me again' check box was selected previously.

COMPATIBILITY WITH MICROSOFT® SQL SERVER 2022

Case Notebook and Case Notebook Administration are now fully compatible with Microsoft SQL Server 2022 as part of our commitment to seamlessly integrate cutting-edge innovation across performance, security, and availability.

UPGRADE TO OPEN SSL (OPEN SECURE SOCKETS LAYER) 3.0.0 WITH TLS (TRANSPORT LAYER SECURITY) 1.2 ENABLED BY DEFAULT

Open SSL (Open Secure Sockets Layer) is a widely used set of encryption tools that provides secure communications using Transport Layer Security (TLS) and Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) protocols over the internet. The Case Notebook suite was upgraded to use Open SSL 3.0.0, which is the newest supported version of this security library, with TLS 1.2 enabled by default.

ABILITY TO CHANGE THE DEFAULT SETTING OF THE 'UNDISPUTED' OPTION FOR KEY FACTS IN CASE NOTEBOOK

Case Notebook users now have the ability to decide if they want to change the default setting of the 'Undisputed' option for Key Facts in the entire application. The 'Undisputed' option is selected by default. Users can contact Customer Technical Support (CTS) for assistance with changing this default setting.

IMPROVED THE UNLOCK CODE ENTRY FUNCTIONALITY

The Unlock code entry box, where users enter an unlock code for certain functions, was changed from three separate boxes to only one box. The 'Copy Unlock to Clipboard' function enables users to copy the entire code with just one click.

UPGRADED OCR (OPTICAL CHARACTER RECOGNITION) ENGINE IN CASE NOTEBOOK

Optical Character Recognition, or OCR, is a technology that enables you to convert different types of documents, such as scanned paper documents, PDF files or images captured by a digital camera into editable and searchable data. Case Notebook utilizes world leading OCR technology from ABBYY, which has now been upgraded to the newest version to provide enhanced performance to users.

OPTION TO DIRECTLY ASSOCIATE A NEW KEY FACT TO THE SOURCE

Once a new key fact is created from the Properties window of a content item, users will be presented with a Yes and No prompt to link this new key fact to the content item or annotation without having to search for it. If the user clicks Yes, then the newly created key fact is automatically selected in the Key Facts tab of the properties dialog for the content item or annotation. If user clicks No, then the new key fact is created, however, it is not selected in the Key Facts tab of the properties dialog for the content item or annotation.

AUTO TAGS CREATED IN TRANSCRIPTS ARE HIGHLIGHTED IN THE MULTI-MONITOR VIEWER WINDOW

Automatically tagged words or phrases in a case using the Auto Tag option are highlighted when the case content is opened in the viewer window.

MODIFIED PERMISSIONS IN MANAGED CASES FOR EXTERNAL AND READER USERS

External and Reader users will no longer have the ability to create, edit, or delete data groups and content items in data groups. In addition, the Create New Case button will be disabled in managed cases for External users. As a result, External users will not have the ability to create a new case when they are accessing a managed case.

CLARITY IN THE MESSAGE REGARDING ENABLING ACTIVE DIRECTORY AUTHENTICATION

Case Notebook Admin users who attempt to reach the Active Directory service with their local credentials will be shown a clear message to inform them that the Active Directory service cannot be reached if they log in as a local user (with their local credentials). They must log in as a domain user in order to reach the Active Directory service and enable Active Directory authentication.

Transport Layer Security (TLS) protocol is an industry standard designed to help protect the privacy of information communicated over the internet. TLS version 1.2 provides security improvements in privacy and data integrity over previous versions. Case Notebook has been upgraded to support TLS 1.2 and will connect properly to repositories for firms that use this protocol.

OPTION TO CONTROL WHICH DATA GROUPS DISPLAY IN THE NAVIGATION PANE

A new field, Data Groups, is now available in the Display Options > General tab in Case Notebook with the 'Hide empty data groups in navigation pane' checkbox. Users can select the checkbox to display only data groups with content in the navigation pane.

NEW SUB-MENU IN THE SORT BY DATA GROUPS MENU FOR CONTENT CATEGORIES IN THE NAVIGATION PANE

At firms using the "Authenticate users against Active Directory" option in Case Notebook Administration, users must be granted the "Access this computer from the network" permission. CREATE CUSTOM CATEGORIES TO ORGANIZE YOUR CASE

Case Managers may create new categories in which to place case content. Instead of just documents and pleadings, up to five new categories may be created and named for the needs of that case. Case Managers may also determine the order in which the content categories appear in the case menus.

MOVE CONTENT ITEMS BETWEEN CATEGORIES

Content items may now be moved between categories. When users upgrade cases from an earlier version of Case Notebook, they may create new custom categories and move content items into those new categories without losing notes, issue marks, custom properties, or other work-product. As a case progresses, a new category of content may be added to the case to enable users to work more efficiently, and content may be moved into the new category.

INCLUDE THE TRANSCRIPT TEXT IN A DESIGNATIONS REPORT

Case Notebook now may include the appropriate section of transcript text associated with a given designation in a properly formatted text report. Users will have the option to include the transcript text with line and page numbering in the report output.

RIGHT-CLICK OPTION FOR SEND TO EMAIL FROM GRID VIEW OR NAVIGATION PANE

Sending a content item out of Case Notebook via email is now an option. This can be done by using the right-click menu on a content item from the navigation pane, or from the grid list in the display pane.

RECOGNITION OF PTX OR PTZ FILES FROM E-TRANSCRIPT MANAGER WITH INTEGRATED SECURITY

Obtain transcripts via email from a court reporting agency in PTX or PTZ file format with enhanced security and import those files into Case Notebook without any additional steps.

Sort cases by most recent case to display up to 15 local or repository cases from most recent to least recent and double-click the case name to open it.

DUPLICATE AN EXISTING KEY FACT

Use an existing key fact as a template, duplicate the properties of a key fact, and create new key facts quickly with the **Duplicate** feature.
