ProSeries 1040 to GoSystem Tax

Thank you for using the GoSystem® Tax Data Conversion Service. This document provides information about the data that you converted from ProSeries® and describes how to use the data in GoSystem Tax.

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What to expect from the data conversion

The overall objective of the GoSystem Tax data conversion is to produce accurate client data for the processing of 2023 tax returns. Data conversions are from the prior year (2022) to the current year (2023). Where applicable, 2022 amounts will generally appear as prior-year amounts in the 2023 return.

We have made every effort to consistently and accurately convert the data listed in this document. However, due to inherent differences in the way ProSeries and GoSystem Tax store and display values, inconsistencies do exist in isolated instances. In some instances, GoSystem Tax requires an entry in a field that does not exist or was left blank in ProSeries. In those isolated instances, a period (".") was placed in the required GoSystem Tax field. To ensure that the 2023 data is accurate and complete, you should conduct a careful review of your converted data and make additions or modifications in GoSystem Tax as necessary.

Items not converted

Due to differences between GoSystem Tax and ProSeries software or data structures, or the item does not rollover to 2023, the following items are not converted. This list is not all inclusive.

After you access your converted data, enter the applicable items at your convenience.

- Historical carryover amount other than amounts listed in the “Items transferred during conversion” section, such as NOL and Non-recaptured Section 1231 for amounts prior to 2022
- Credits not otherwise specified, such as the General Business Credit
- State information
- Form 6198 Regular and AMT at-risk amounts for Schedules C, E, F, and K-1 and Form 4835
- Passive activity loss amounts for Schedules C, E, F, and K-1 and Form 4835
- General business credit carryover
- 1116 information other than amounts listed in the section items converted
- Form 8801 fields other than amounts listed in the section items converted
- Depletion

Conversion notes and exceptions

The following section contains additional detail to assist in review of the information that has been converted.

Dates

If only the year was entered in a ProSeries date field, the date converted to GoSystem Tax as July 1 of that year. If only the month and year were entered in ProSeries, the date converted to GoSystem Tax as the first of the month.

Two-Year Comparison

2022 ProSeries federal two-year comparison amounts convert to prior-year amounts on 2023 Organizer screens as prior-year amounts.

Schedule A

- Prior-year Schedule A descriptions.
- Non-cash items, regardless of amount, convert to non-cash items less than \$500.

Estimates

Review prior-year estimated tax payments and overpayments applied.

Schedule K-1 Activities

- Assets entered in the Depreciation and Amortization folders will not convert.
- For 1065 and 1120 Schedules K-1, you must enter a Partnership name and a Corporation. Otherwise, the activity will convert with a period (".") as the description name.
- Descriptions of "Other income" and "Other deductions" items do not convert.

Depreciation

- Assets convert for Schedule C, Schedule E, Schedule F, and Form 2106.
- Section 179 carryovers do not convert.
- Asset descriptions are limited to 20 characters.
- Please add vehicle use information to the tax return data for 2023. Indicate if luxury auto limits are applicable.
- The method MACRS 150%, when the Indian property designation is present, could not be converted. Additional data entry will be required.
- Tax preference code "P" for amortization of certified pollution control facilities was not converted.
- By default, book treatment information is converted using the federal values and requires modification. Please review all book treatment values, including accumulated depreciation, for accuracy.

Schedule E

Vacation Home and/or Personal Property data entry in ProSeries will automatically create a Rental Property in GoSystem Tax. Vacation Homes and Personal Properties are not converted to the like-kind activities in GoSystem Tax.
