CURRENT CONTENT PRIORITIES


The following Tax Law Updates are current content priorities:

JURISDICTION	UPDATE
Italy	Introduction of the new September 30 deadline (or the last day of the ninth month) for corporation income tax return – effective from the tax year ending December 31, 2024 and beyond.
Maine	Extension of time to file corporate income tax returns from 6 to 7 months for fiscal years not ending on June 30 or December 31.
New Jersey	Proposed a new simplified standardized return to replace the CBT-100 and CBT-100U – expected to be effective from tax year 2024.

APPLYING TAX LAW UPDATES


To apply a tax law update, complete the following steps:

- 1 Within the **Calendar Setup** module, select **Tax Law Update**, then select **Event Templates**. The **Pending Event Templates** window opens and displays a grid of any tax law updates that have not been processed.
