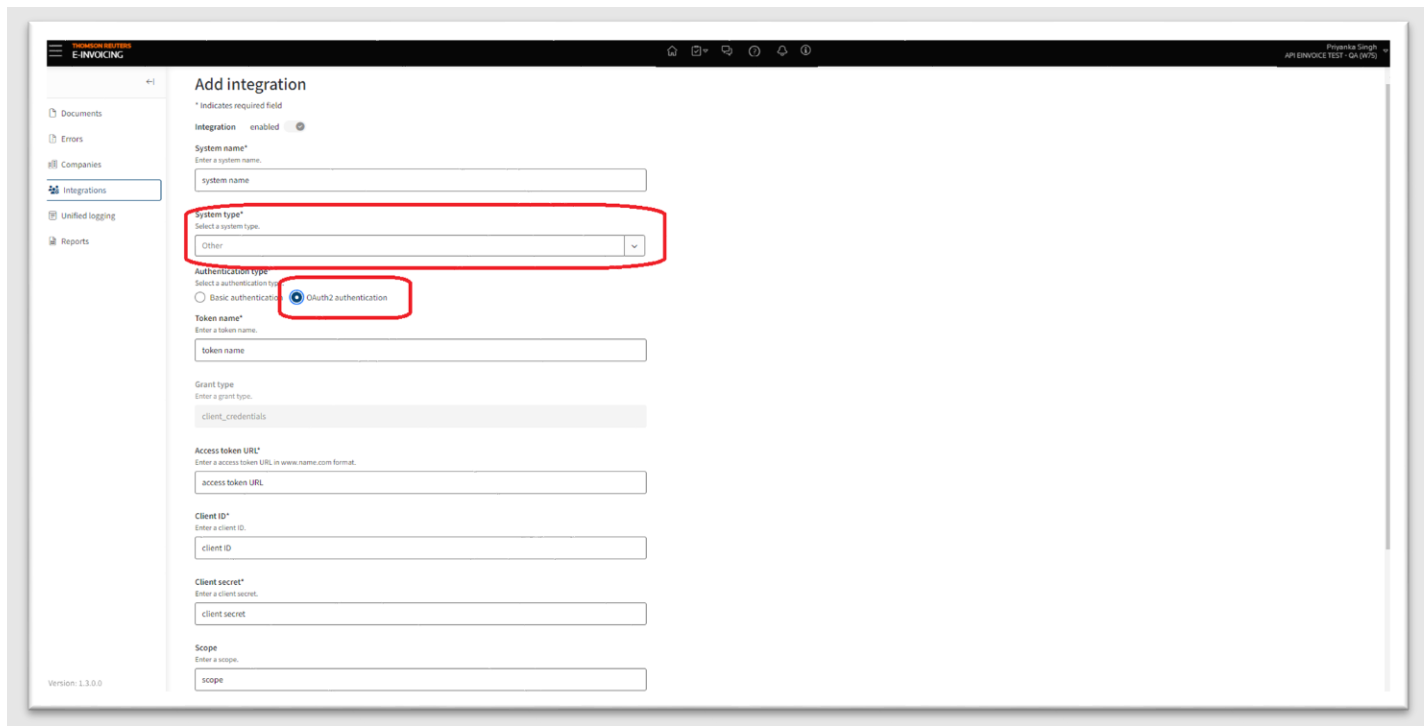
External System - Support for OAuth2 Authentication

The latest update introduces multiple authentication methods within the ERP integration module, specifically for External System integration. This enhancement allows users to assign authentication configurations to External systems in OEI, choosing OAuth2 authentication processes. It simplifies the authentication setup process, enabling users to enter necessary details effortlessly and manage OAuth2 authentication types efficiently for each legal entity.

Key Features:

- 1. OAuth2 Authentication Configuration Section:**
 - A new section for OAuth2 authentication configurations is available on the External System integration page.
- 2. Flexible Authentication Options:**
 - Users can choose between Basic and OAuth2 authentication processes.
 - For Basic authentication, users input Username, Password, and URL.
 - For OAuth2 authentication, users provide Token Name, Grant Type, Access Token URL, Client ID, Client Secret, Scope, and URL. The default Grant Type is set to "Client Credentials."
- 3. Authentication Type Selection:**
 - Users can select either Basic or OAuth2 authentication processes for a legal entity.
 - A fourth column named "Authentication Type" is displayed under the legal entity grid, where users can see the authentication type for each legal entity.

How to Access: To access the new authentication configuration section, navigate to the External integration page within the ERP integration module. Users can set up authentication options and manage authentication types for External legal entities from this page.



Changes in SAP and External ERP Integration Form

In this patch release, the fields Username and Password for OAuth2 authentication type have been removed. Additionally, the field Scope has been made optional for both SAP and External Integration forms. This change streamlines the authentication setup and ensures a more efficient configuration process.
