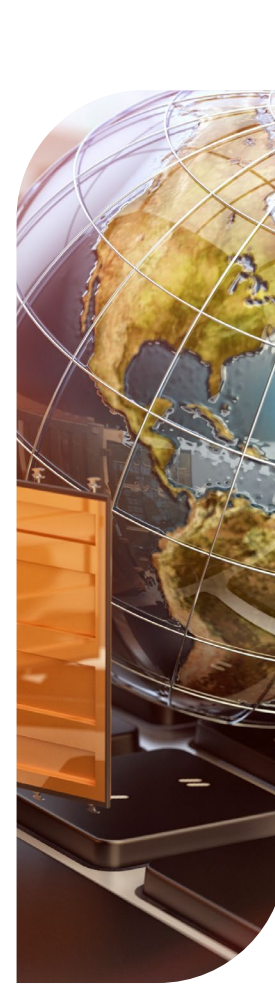

CPS – GENERAL INFORMATION

- Mandatory Filing for CPS:
 - For non-06 entry types, mandatory filing is July 2026
 - For 06 entry types, mandatory filing is January 8, 2027
- If you want to file prior to the mandatory date, please observe the following:
 - Sign up with CPS for their voluntary program. You need to visit the following site for information on the voluntary program: <https://www.cpsc.gov/eFiling>
 - CPS/CBP have not flagged any HTS for CPS data currently. If you want to begin practicing and filing during the Voluntary Program, you must turn CPS data on for **ALL** products. Without the flags on the HTS from CBP, we have no way to limit CPS data, so it must be turned on for all. It doesn't mean you need to file for every product during the voluntary program, though. Please see below on how you can turn on the flagging yourself, for CPS in the ONESOURCE system.
 - During the Voluntary Program, CPS indicated they would not turn on fatal edits on the CPS data. They indicated they would give warnings for incorrect information to help educate on the requirements.

CPS – GENERAL INFORMATION - CONTINUED

- How to file CPS Data on an Entry:
 - CPS has two ways to file data on entries:
 - Reference Message Set:
 - Utilize the CPS Product Registry and supply the data to CPS.
 - Then file a limited PGA message set on your Entry that will reference the registry information.
 - Full Message Set:
 - Do not utilize the CPS Product Registry.
 - File a complete PGA message set on your Entry.
- For FTZ's- 06 Entry Filing - CPS/CBP wants CPS Data filed on the 3461/Estimate.
 - CPS has indicated that if you hold multiple valid certificates for products in your inventory that may ship out during your zone week, you must supply a PGA message set for each certificate for that product.
 - Hierarchy of CPS data per HTS on a 3461 Estimate:
 - HTS
 - May consist of multiple Products
 - Each Product may consist of multiple valid Certificates. File a CPS PGA Message Set for every valid Certificate



CPS – GENERAL INFORMATION - CONTINUED

- Multiple ways to obtain CPS data on the 3461 Estimate:
 - Key the CPS certificate data directly onto the Estimate as you do for other PGA's.
 - Copy Current will include PGA data if that is utilized going forward.

CPS – GENERAL INFORMATION - CONTINUED

- Key the CPS certificate data into GC first as you do for other PGA Products:
 - GC has the ability to store multiple CPS message sets per product.
 - Once the data is keyed into GC, go to your Estimate and on your HTS , provide the Product Num that relates to that HTS that has all of the needed PGA Message sets for that HTS on your 3461 Estimate. Once that is selected, you can utilize the 'Get Classification PGA Data' link on the 3461 Estimate to pull the CPS data from GC.

CPS – GENERAL INFORMATION - CONTINUED

Currently CPSC is not flagging HTS for CPS needed reporting. They will not flag the HTS until full implementation on 7/8/2026. Below is in the CPSC/efiling FAQ's regarding HTS:

– Will CPSC identify and flag specific CBP HTS codes for CPSC data review during the eFiling voluntary stage? What about after the full implementation date?

CPSC **will not** be flagging HTS codes for CPSC data review during the eFiling voluntary stage.

CPSC **will** be flagging HTS codes for CPSC data review upon eFiling full implementation.

If you wish to file CPSC information in the Voluntary stage prior to the Full Implementation, you will need to turn on the CPS Override PGA Flags in the PGA Settings Menu:

Note, when this is set to Y, the CPS agency will show for all parts. Without the flags on the HTS, we have no way to know what parts need it, so it will have to show for all. You can choose to file or not.



CPS – GENERAL INFORMATION - CONTINUED

- Interfaces
 - Inbound Interfaces – If you have an internal feed into ONESOURCE Global Trade that you wish to add/modify for CPS changes, you will need an *SOW project for Implementation/Testing purposes.
 - Outbound Interfaces –
 - Self-Filers – Any file updates for CPS filings that are made directly to CBP, will automatically be made for these types of files.
 - FTZ Broker Filers –
 - If you utilize the ONESOURCE Global Trade’s Standard ACE CATAIR, file updates for CPS will automatically be made for these files.
 - All other broker feeds or interfaces to third parties from ONESOURCE Global Trade will need an *SOW project for Implementation/Testing purposes.

*SOW Projects – The reason these require SOW projects is because every interface is unique to an operation and OneSource does not own the specifications. Time is needed to coordinate what should be transmitted between parties for each design and a test site available for testing. If you need an SOW project, please contact your account manager.

PG19 through PG21 are records that will be used to provide:

- A. An Entity: Certifying Entity, Manufacturer, Independent Third Party Lab, Lab, No Lab testing required, Point of Contact.
 - Each Full Message Set requires a Manufacturer and at least one of the lab entity options.
 - If “FCP” is used as the Government Agency Processing Code in PG01, then only an Independent Third Party Lab “ITL” can be reported.
 - The Certifying Entity is only required if the Importer of Record (IOR) is not certifying the certificate data.⁶
 - The Point of Contact (party maintaining records of test results) is only required if the Importer of Record (IOR) is not maintaining the records.⁷
